
What to expect

My style: I am calm and patient, but also work fast and efficiently. I am creative and passionate. My style is wide and inclusive: it is important that every client is understood and satisfied. I know how to anticipate and capture the moments that convey all the special feelings. When the day is over, your memories will be enhanced through photographs of the two of you looking at one another or simply being together, thus narrating the story of your love, which will leave the most lasting impressions on the heart.

Wedding day portraits: For couple portrait estimate approximately 1 hour. The best time is about an hour before sunset. If not at your venue, a nearby park or close-by outdoor area would be a perfect location.

Payment terms: A 50% non-refundable deposit is required to reserve your date on the calendar. The rest is to be paid two weeks prior to the session.





Engagement Session

This session is so I can truly get to know you two as a couple and help us all feel comfortable together before your big day.



DETAILS & GETTING READY

Location: When deciding where to go for your engagement photos It's important to think about a place that's special to the two of you. Let your imagination run wild. Do you love sandy toes and splashing in the waves or is taking a stroll through the woods more your thing. How about pizza and beers in the back of your pick up?

I am also here for suggestions. Just let me know. I have a bunch of ideas.



Outfit: The next thing that comes to mind is “What to wear?” Choosing an outfit for photos might be the most stressful factor for some people. To make it as effortless as possible, use pictures for inspiration and wear something that makes YOU feel comfortable. Confidence always shines through in photos. When discussing the outfit, pay more attention to complementary colors and solid prints. Try to stay away from anything busy, as it can be a distraction in photos.

Choose pastels, cool hues, and neutral tones, avoid anything neon. Focus on adding bright accents by accessories.

Wedding day tips



Getting everything ready and gathering all the details before the day starts can help the shooting to go smoothly. It will allow me to be more focused on capturing spontaneous moments. Some items you might need to put all together in advance: ring, flowers, shoes, socks, cufflinks, pictures, gifts, cultural items, invitations, and programs.



Bride Prep | Bride getting ready

Ideal time allotment: 120-150 min

Ideal time of the day: Morning

Ideal location: Bedroom, Specially designed room, outdoor

I will photograph the details and the bride's morning look. Do not forget the dress, perfume, flowers, and accessories.



Groom Prep | Groom getting ready

Ideal time allotment: 60-120 min

Ideal time of the day: Morning

Ideal location: Room, outdoor

I will start photographing while the boys are getting ready. I focus more on the finishing stages of the men getting ready.



Frequently asked questions

HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE TO GET ALL THE PHOTOS?

There is a two-month window to edit all the photos and send them to you. Sometimes this can be more or less depending on the season. However, you will be informed about the timing in advance.

WILL WE GET THE PRINT VERSION OF OUR PHOTOS?

Upon receiving your photos, you will get a full print release. You're able to order prints directly through me or print them through another company if you'd like.

HOW MANY PHOTOS CAN WE EXPECT FROM THE WEDDING SESSION?

You can expect about 75 images an hour that are retouched, cropped and color-corrected photos. The number of images in your gallery will always depend on your day, but not to worry there are always plenty. All final photos belong to you.

DO YOU PHOTOGRAPH A DESTINATION WEDDING?

Yes! I love traveling. Just make sure to communicate with me all the details and travel plans, and I will create a custom wedding collection to meet your needs.

HOW AND WHEN DO WE BOOK THE DATE?
